


MAIN HOUSE SEATING

Below you can find images of the seating in our Main House Auditorium. Further in this pack you will find some measurements of our seat, along with some additional accessibility information.

Entrance to the Main House is either through Door A or Door B which are located in the foyer on either side of the Café Bar area.

There are a few steps leading to both Door A and Door B. There are stairs once inside Doors A and B

There is a platform-lift to assist in accessing the auditorium via Door A and a passenger lift to assist in accessing the auditorium via Door B.



There are 16 rows in our auditorium (Rows A-P). Each row has between 14 – 35 seats.

Each row from B to P has two steps, each 7 inches deep.

Wheelchair spaces are:

- · B1, B2 (companion seat) accessed via Door A
- · B21 (companion seat), B22 accessed via Door B

We can also provide wheelchair spaces in our Access Gallery which is located at the rear of the auditorium. Access Gallery wheelchair spaces are Q1, Q2 (companion seat), Q3 and Q4 (companion seat)




The Access Gallery is a separate theatre box on level 2 and can be accessed by a lift next to the Box Office. Please note that bookings in the access you may share the gallery with another party.

Below are some approximate measurements taken of our Main House seats:

Width of seat: 13.5 Inches

Space between armrests: 18 inches.

Length of seat: 18 Inches

Length of armrest: 9 inches

Height of seat (from top of backrest to the seat itself): 19 inches

Please note the armrests are not removable.

There is however the option of being seated in armless seats in our Access Gallery.
